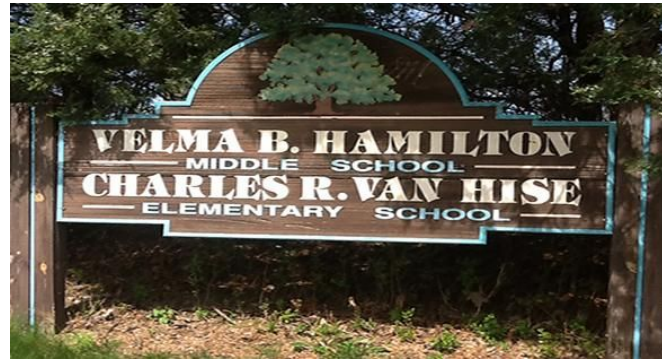


School Profile: Hamilton Middle School

Hamilton Middle School is Madison Metropolitan School District's largest middle school, with over 800 students representing countries and cultures from all over the world. Hamilton's student body is committed to excellence and is supported by the entire school community. At Hamilton, students are provided rigorous learning experiences in all subject areas to ensure that they are prepared for high school and beyond. Hamilton's vision is for all students to feel they belong here and see themselves as learners with the ability to grow socially, emotionally and academically.



Strengths

Hamilton is a robust learning community where students believe that school is cool! At Hamilton, students believe they can learn, and they make efforts to learn even when the work is challenging. Students report feeling safe at school, that teachers care about them and that staff hold them to high expectations. Families report that Hamilton has approachable and responsive staff that help students achieve goals.

Progress

According to 2015-16 MAP Fall to Spring data, Hamilton increased the number of overall students proficient in Math and Reading. Most notable progress in increased reading proficiency: 9% for African American students, 9% for English Language Learners. Most notable progress in increased math proficiency: 15% for African American students, 9% for Low Income students.

Areas for Growth

Hamilton's primary area for growth is to provide differentiated instruction for all learners. In particular, Hamilton needs to work to support African American students and Advanced Learners in meeting MAP growth goal targets for reading and math.

Our school supports MMSD's vision that all students acquire the skills and abilities needed to be successful, including a mastery of content areas, growth mindset, self-knowledge, creativity, wellness, interpersonal skills, confidence, cultural competence, and community connection. 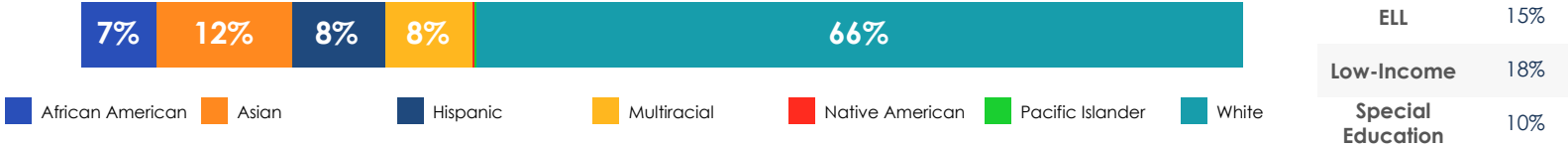

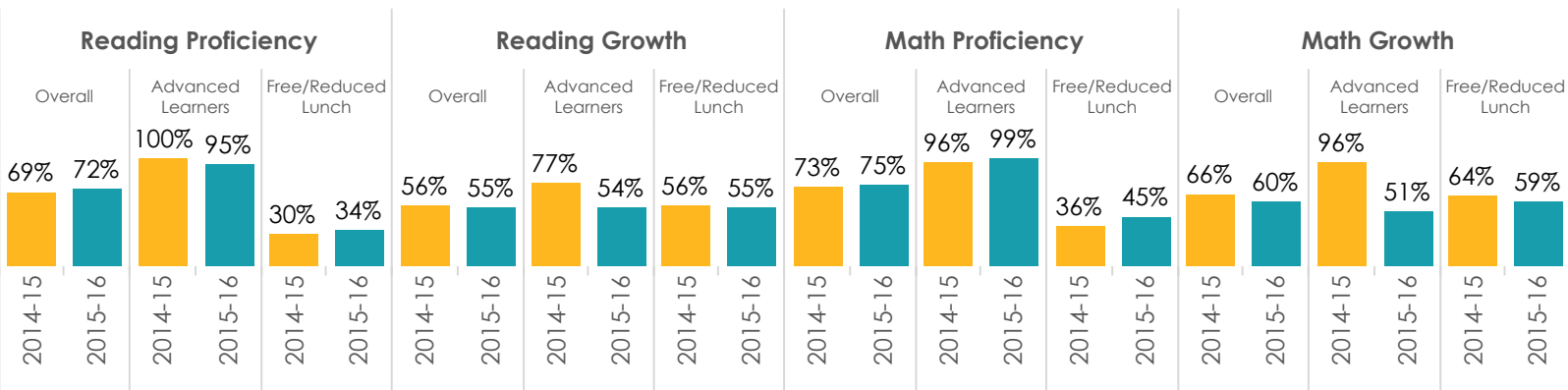

Strategic Framework Goal #1 Milestones: On-Track to Graduate

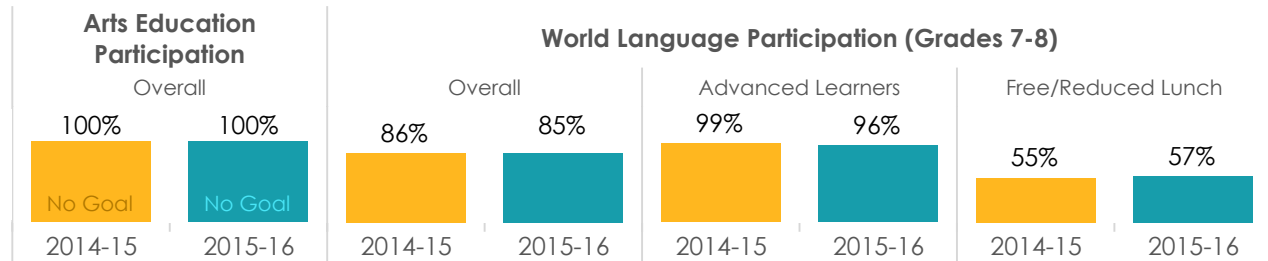
Each bar shows the percent of students meeting the relevant metric overall and for the focus groups the school selected on their School Improvement Plan (SIP, when applicable).
