Most notable area of student progress was a 12% increase in the number of students meeting their fall to spring MAP Math growth goals. Along with our student achievement data, families also indicated an increased level of engagement with our school community.

Hamilton's primary area for growth is to continue to improve differentiated literacy instruction in all classrooms, for all learners. This work will be addressed through professional development, teacher collaboration and family engagement.

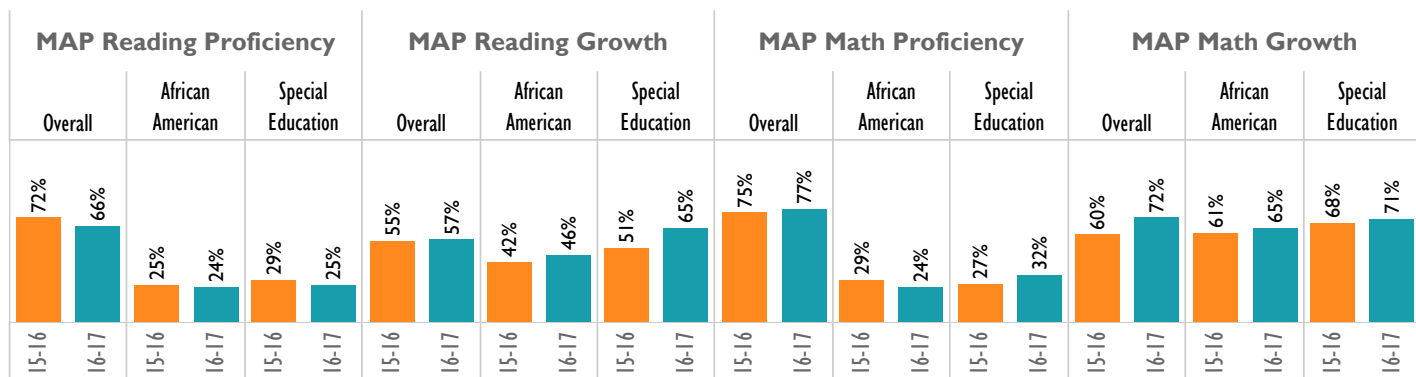

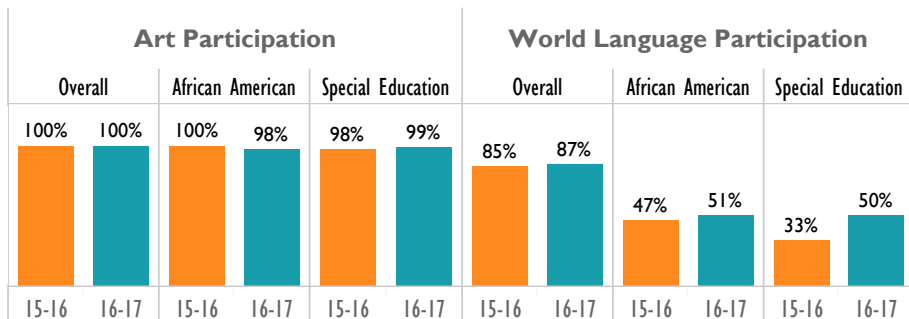
